INGLEWOOD ceramic artist Amanda Shelsher makes a welcome return with her first solo exhibition in Perth since taking on the world.

Shelsher will be exhibiting her nature-inspired works in *Garden of Curiosities* at the Form Gallery on Murray Street until July 21.

Her sculptures have been exhibited at prestigious art fairs in London and Chicago and have traveled to Taipei, Hong Kong and Korea, as well as throughout the Eastern States.

Raglan Gallery Sydney, Skepsi Gallery Melbourne and the Beaver Galleries in Canberra are just a few of Australia's leading galleries to have exhibited her sculptural pieces.

Shelsher said her work came from a desire for a closer relationship with Mother Nature.

"I hope to deliver works that open our eyes to nature's beauty and also the inter-relationships people have with nature," she said.

All pieces are hand-built through a slab and coil technique and are hollow and unique.

Her art is displayed in dozens of homes across the world including that of famous comedian Billy Connolly.
